

## Prime development site at Adelaide ship-building hub sold for \$1.2 million

16,680sqm Techport lot purchased by LMLL Pty Ltd

**10 May 2018, Adelaide –** A large industrial site at Osborne's ship-building hub has been sold to LMLL Pty Ltd for \$1.2 million. Sold via private treaty, the 16,680 square metre lot attracted significant interest given its prime location, in the Supplier Precinct, at Techport Australia; home to Adelaide's expanding maritime industry.

With over 100 metre frontage to Nelcebee Street, the lot is ideally positioned for business supporting the future naval shipbuilding and maintenance contracts.

Knight Frank's Sales and Leasing Executive, Industrial, South Australia, Garry Partington, said the strong growth of Osbourne's ship-building industry resulted in significant interest in the site.
