## The location

Surrounded on three sides by the Surrey Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, Guildford is a popular choice for enjoying both town and country living and within 30 miles of central London.

## The property

An attractive, early 19th century, semi-detached property, offering tremendous potential for the incoming purchaser. Currently in a neglected state, this property will appeal to a wide audience due to its attractive stuccoed elevation with black railings and speared tops, as well as its excellent central location and its huge renovation potential. Arranged over three floors, the ground floor consists of two reception areas; a formal living room and a study/snug.



The lower ground floor has the potential for a kitchen and separate dining room, with the potential to extend to the rear, subject to the usual planning consent.

The first floor consists of two bedrooms and a family bathroom. There is also a sizable loft for storage. A particularly fine feature of this rare opportunity is that the property still retains some of its original features including some of the wooden shutters, staircase and timber doors.

Outside is a good sized area with potential to become a fabulous outdoor space. There is a block paved driveway for vehicular parking to the front of the property that continues down the side, into the rear garden.

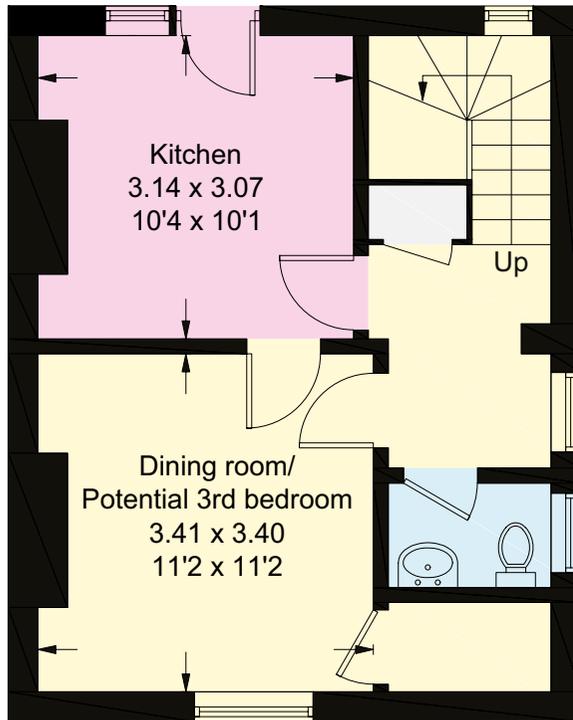

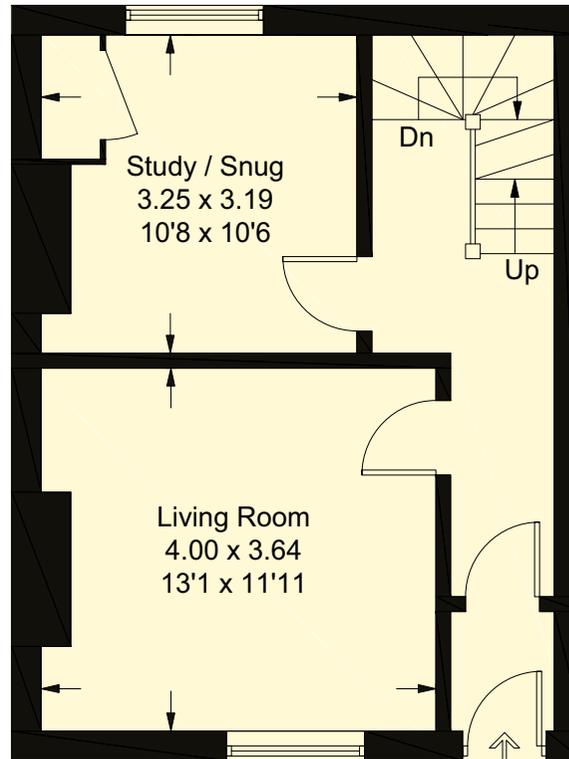

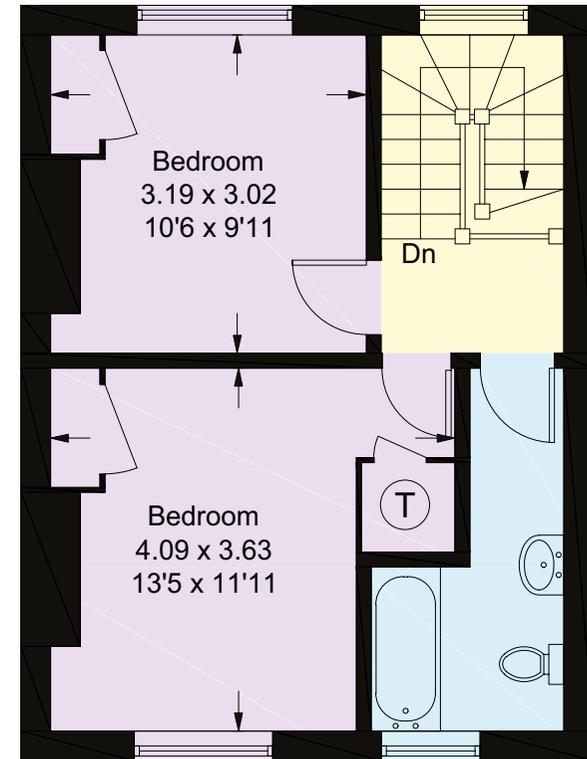
