





A highly valuable two-bedroom Mews house—connected via a private subterranean passage—provides an extraordinary level of privacy, flexibility and security seldom found in central London.

At first floor level, the main house presents a breathtaking, full-width reception room with exceptional ceiling heights and uninterrupted south-facing views across the River Thames. This lateral space epitomises the home's grandeur, offering exquisite period detailing paired with refined modern finishes. A passenger lift discreetly services all principal floors, enhancing convenience while preserving the architectural integrity of the property.









Throughout, the specification is exemplary—marrying sophisticated modern technology and design with the inherent character of this historic residence. At garden level, a magnificent formal dining room leads to an impressive Boffi kitchen, where full-width bi-folding doors open seamlessly onto a beautifully landscaped private garden, creating an exceptional setting for indoor-outdoor living and large-scale entertaining.

The bedroom accommodation is arranged with exceptional consideration for luxury, privacy and comfort. Occupying an entire floor, the principal suite is a statement of elegance and scale, featuring a grand bedroom with large sash windows, superb natural light and tranquil views. 
