On the ground floor, the heart of the home is the impressive kitchen/dining area which is superbly presented with fitted units, granite work surfaces, integrated appliances and space for a fridge freezer and range cooker. A centre island provides a breakfast bar and the glass covered spiral wine cellar creates a striking feature. The well-proportioned sitting room centres on an exposed brick chimney breast with wood burning stove and has a dual aspect with French windows to the terrace and garden. In addition there is a study, separate family room and a later extension providing a utility room and cloakroom.

On the first floor, exposed beams add to the character feel of the property. The main bedroom has views of fields across the lane and has a wellappointed en suite shower room. The three further double bedrooms are of generous proportions and there is a beautiful family bathroom with roll top bath and separate shower cubicle.

Set back from Hurst Lane, with a pretty front garden, the majority of garden extends to the rear of the house. A stone terrace immediately to the back the house has a brick built pizza oven. Gently rising steps lead to a part walled garden with a lawn and mature shrub and flower borders. Adjacent to the house are four parking spaces and a double garage.










