Mayfair Village is home to some of the most fashionable boutiques, luxurious hotels and desirable restaurants in Europe, as well as some of London's most coveted properties. Other places of interest include the Royal Academy, the Handel House Museum and Shepherd Market.

### Sport and leisure facilities:

As well as having the gardens at Berkeley Square and Grosvenor Square, large parks including Green Park and Hyde Park are a short walk away. Hyde Park is a great spot for picnics, running, cycling and horse riding, and in the summer months the Serpentine is popular for boating and open-air swimming.

### Getting around:

The Punch Bowl, a gastro pub with a well-known owner; Mount Street Deli, for its unctuous chocolate cake; and Shepherd Market, for independent shops and restaurants.
